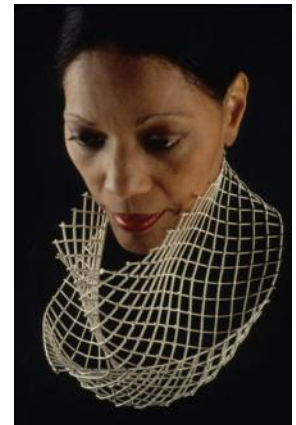

A retrospective exhibition of one of the most esteemed jewelry artists in the Pacific Northwest.

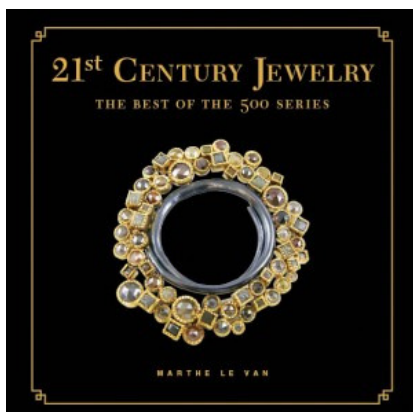

Garnet, January's Gem Stone



The name garnet originates with the Latin *granatum malum* which means pomegranate. There are no known enhancements for garnet and the gem occurs in every color of the spectrum, except blue. One example is this exquisite butterfly brooch circa 1890 in 14k yellow gold encrusted with diamonds, opal, ruby, emeralds, and green garnets for \$4,680.
