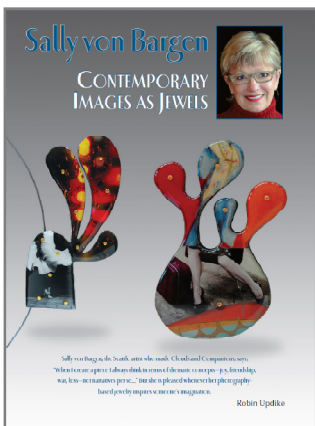
**Carolyn Tillie's** 'Nigiri' bracelet was featured in the April issue of Italian *Elle* magazine.

**Daive Bigazzi's** YouTube video was part of the 'Treasures of Heaven' exhibit at the Walters Art Museum in Baltimore, MD.

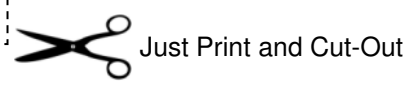

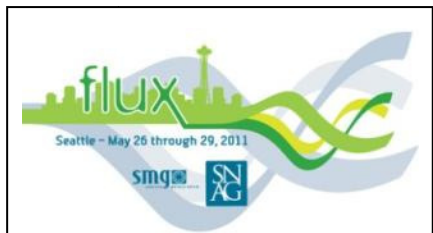
