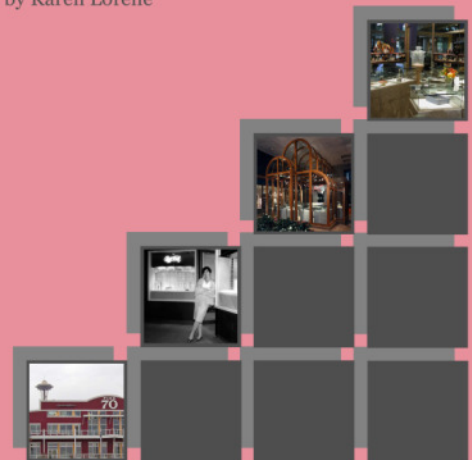

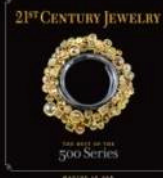
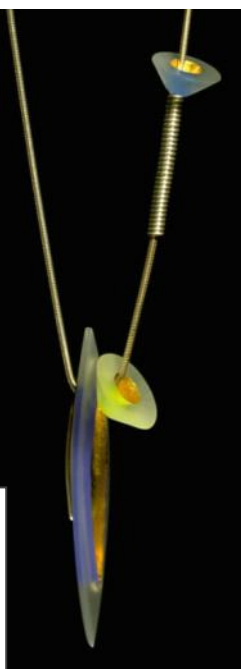
Print and Cut-Out
